Reception classes parents came in for a fantastic family event. As well as enjoying s'mores, Mrs Naylor led singing around the campfire.

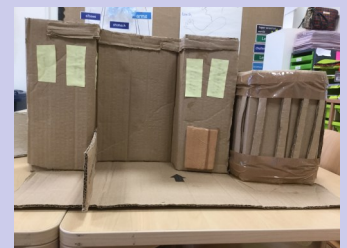


It was so exciting, so happy seeing campfire, enjoyed with my son, thank you for the lovely time.
