Cyberbullying:

Discuss cyberbullying with your child: ask them what their understanding of cyberbullying is, and how it is different to physical and face to face bullying. Often young people can confuse bullying with 'banter' and are reluctant to talk to others for fear of being seen to 'not be able to take a joke'. Ask your children how they would react if they were being cyberbullied, or if their friend was being cyberbullied. Explore together to learn how to block and report people or messages and discuss who they could talk to if they were worried about this.
