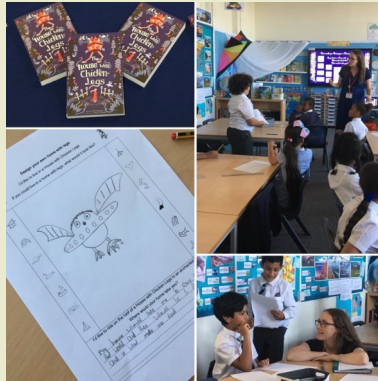


George is doing an excellent job as Liverpool's Junior Lord Mayor.
