What are we going to be learning?

PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT



- Keep play going by responding to what others are saying or doing.
- Talk with confidence to their friends about home and community.
- Separate from main carer with support and encouragement.
- Seek out others to share experiences.

COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE

- Listening to stories with increasing attention and recall.
- Retell a simple past event in the correct order.
- Learn new words very rapidly and use them in communicating.
- Shows an interest in play with sounds, songs and rhymes.


PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT



- To move freely with pleasure and confidence in a range of ways.
- Use one handed tools and equipment.
- Draw lines and circles using gross motor movements.
- To be independent in self care.
- To put on own coat and be able to fasten it alone.
- Climb confidently and begin to pull themselves up on nursery climbing equipment.
- Show control in holding and using jugs to pour, hammers, books and mark-making tools.



LITERACY



- Describe main story settings, events and
- principal characters.
- Sometimes give meanings to the marks they make as the draw and paint
- Recognise familiar words and signs such as own name and advertising logos.
- Give meaning to marks they make as they draw, write and paint.

MATHS



- To use number names and language spontaneously in play.
- Realise anything can be counted.
- Show interest in shape and space by playing with shapes or making arrangements with objects.
- Select a small number of objects from a group.
- Begins to categorise objects according to properties such as shape or size.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

- Looking at our own features and what makes us unique.
- Recognising and describing special times and events for family and friends.
 - Show an interest in technological toys.
 - Noticing detailed features of objects and their environment.

EXPRESSIVE ARTS AND DESIGN

- We will be having weekly visits from our music teacher who will be helping us to tap our simple repeated rhythms and build our repertoire of songs.
- Engaging in role play to share experiences from home. Playing alongside friends who are engaged in the same theme.
