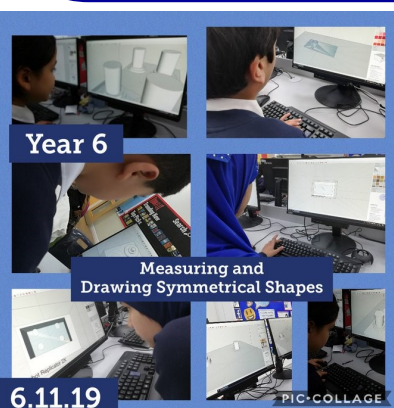
Year 3 Visit to Sudley House
