School Uniform List

Children in Reception, KS1 and KS2

White Shirt (not polo shirt)

Grey skirt / grey pinafore dress / grey shorts / grey trousers (not jogging bottoms)

Grey or navy tights

Blue gingham dress (Summer)

Navy blue Smithdown Primary V-neck sweatshirt / Smithdown Primary cardigan

Smithdown Primary school tie

Flat, black, leather-look shoes (not trainers)

Head scarfs for older girls must be navy or white and short and plain (no pattern or sparkles)

Simple, plain, hairbands or bobbles

A small stud earing may be worn – no other jewellery.

PE Kit – To be worn every PE lesson

Navy sports short (plain)

Navy leggings or jogging bottoms (plain)

Light blue polo shirt (not t-shirt)

Trainers or plimsolls (Velcro fastening in EYFS and KS1 if children cannot fasten laces)

Swimming kit – one piece swimsuit or fitted swimming shorts (not beach style) and a swimming hat.

Nursery

White polo shirt

Grey trousers / skirt / pinafore / shorts /jogging bottoms

Navy blue Smithdown Primary V-neck sweatshirt / Smithdown Primary cardigan

Flat black school shoes (Velcro fastening)
