PLACE VALUE

- Count within 100, forwards and backwards
- Count to and across 20, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or from any given number
- Read and write numbers from 1 to 20 in numerals and words
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations, including the number line, and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least
- Given a number, identify one more and one less (numbers between 1 and 20)

ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION

- Read, write and interpret mathematical statements involving (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs
- Represent and use bonds and related subtraction facts within 20
- Add and subtract one-digit and two-digit numbers to 20, including zero

SEASONAL CHANGES - ONGOING

Pupils will understand how weather conditions vary in each season and how the day length also varies throughout the year.

ANIMALS INCLUDING HUMANS

Pupils will be familiar with a variety of common animals and will be able to identify which are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.

Pupils will understand parts of the human body and its senses.

WORKING SCIENTIFICALLY

Pupils will ask simple questions and suggest answers using observations and ideas. They will also identify and classify.
