





Year 2 Spring 1 Half Termly Curriculum Overview

 English	<u>The Secret Sky Garden</u> <p>We are studying the beautiful book 'The Secret Sky Garden.' We will look at extended noun phrases and how to use conjunctions as well as applying our phonic and spelling knowledge. We will create posters, diaries and narrative stories.</p>	 Maths	<u>Addition and Subtraction</u> <p>We will finish our topic from. The children will learn to add and subtract two 2-digit numbers. They will be taught how to solve problems and reason.</p> <u>Multiplication and Division</u> <p>The children will learn to recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables. They will be taught how to solve problems involving multiplication and division.</p>	 Science	Materials and their uses <p>We will be identifying and comparing the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard for particular uses.</p>
 History	<u>Titanic</u> <p>We will be looking at the local links to Liverpool, significant people on board, why people boarded Titanic, what happened during the disaster, the class systems and what has changed since the disaster.</p>	 R.E.	<u>Who is Muslim and what so they believe?</u> <p>The children will learn about Islam, finding out about Muslim ways of life and beliefs, so they can develop thoughtful views and ideas.</p>	 PHSE	Dreams and Goals <p>The children will think about their own aspirations and how to achieve goals. They will understand the different emotions that can come with this.</p>

 <p>PE</p>	<p>Gymnastics We are learning how to hold eight different balances, create sequences of balances, travel on apparatus and link travelling and balancing together. We are also thinking about how to start and finish a sequence like a gymnast.</p>	 <p>Art</p>	<p>Expressive Painting We will be looking at the artists Marela Zacarius and Charlie French and how they use paint. We will be looking at primary and secondary colours (colour mixing.) We will be using paint to explore the ocean and Titanic and we will use tools to change what the paint looks like.</p>	 <p>Music</p> <p>Working with our Music specialist, Mrs Naylor, the children will be continuing to develop their understanding of rhythm, beat and tempo. They will begin to read rhythm syllables at levels 1 and 2.</p>
