


Year 5 Spring 1 Half Termly Curriculum Overview

 <p>English</p> <p>We will be looking at the book 'Curiosity' by Marcus Motum. We will be exploring non-fictional texts, job applications, speeches and biographies.</p>	 <p>Maths</p> <p>In Maths, Year 5 will develop their understanding of money, calculate area and perimeter, and build confidence with long multiplication and division to solve increasingly complex problems.</p>	 <p>Science</p> <p>In Science, Year 5 will explore space by learning about the Sun, Earth and Moon, the movement of planets in our solar system, and how these movements explain day and night, seasons, and the phases of the Moon.</p>
