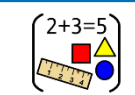


Year 1 Autumn 1 Half Termly Curriculum Overview

 English	This term, children will read <i>The Very Hungry Caterpillar</i> and <i>Where the Wild Things Are</i>. They will talk about the stories, learn new vocabulary and create their own simple story writing based on these texts.	 Maths	This term, children will revisit previous Reception experiences and count within 100 in a variety of ways. The children will use part-whole models to understand how numbers can be split and combined.	 Science	This term, children will learn about parts of the body, the five senses, and autumn, including the seasonal changes they can see around them.
 Geography	This term, children will learn about their local area and Smithdown Primary School. They will explore familiar places, learn about their surroundings, and develop a better understanding of the community around them.	 R.E.
